◆ Visit from Transparency International

In November, TTTI welcomed Transparency International's Americas Advisor, Jessica Ebrard and National Integrity Action (NIA), Research Coordinator/Analyst, Omar Lewis. Meetings were held with TTTI Directors/staff; Senator the Honourable Stuart Young; Mr. David Robinson, Criminal Justice Advisor, British High Commission; His Excellency Dr Lutz Gorgens, German Ambassador and His Excellency *Michael Freudenberg*, Deputy German Ambassador.

In the meeting with Minister Stuart Young, he assured TTTI that proclamation/implementation of the

Procurement legislation will be effected by March 2017. Additionally, TTTI reiterated the urgent need for Campaign Finance Legislation and the Minister gave his commitment that legislation will be in place before the next General Election. Other items discussed were: Beneficial Ownership Register, whistle-blower legislation and the Revenue Authority.

Ms. Ebrard also had the pleasure of meeting immediate former Chair, Deryck Murray, who continues to be TTTI's representative and Transparency International's spokesman for issues relating to corruption in sport.
